Minutes of extraordinary meeting held 23 February 2009

Present: Cllr Mrs J Watson (Chair), Cllr N Collingridge (Vice Chair), Cllr M Burge, Cllr P Corke, Cllr A Gribble.

1. Apologies for Absence: Cllr S Day.

2. To discuss and agree the remedial works to the hall south window: It has been discovered that the south window of the hall was not installed correctly in accordance with the original plans of the hall. It is unlikely that any recourse would be successful from the architect or building company who designed and built the hall. Following advice from an architect plans have been produced to enable work to be carried out to rectify the unsatisfactory installation of the window and correct the original problem of rotting timbers at its base. Although the architect is confident the solution will solve all the problems satisfactorily it does not follow best practice and he cannot guarantee the work. After studying the plans and much discussion councillors voted unanimously to go ahead with the architect's plans.

3. To discuss preliminary plans for the Children's Centre: Councillors viewed two plans showing an impression of the hall to include the Children's Centre. Architectural details were discussed including the pitch of the roof and possible construction materials. Cllrs agreed that one priority in the progressing of the plans should be the aesthetic appearance of the hall.
